## GENERAL INFORMATION

**AdjuTec<sup>™</sup> AMS GOLD PLUS** is a blend of surfactants and ammonium sulfate provided as one convenient, multifunctional liquid. **AdjuTec AMS GOLD PLUS** is designed for use with glyphosate, glufosinate and other pesticide products that require the combination of AMS and surfactant. Pest control is achieved by the combination of improved spreading, reduction of hard water antagonism and enhanced uptake of the pesticide.

**AdjuTec AMS GOLD PLUS** is a unique surfactant for pesticide formulations, more specifically for glyphosate formulations. **AdjuTec AMS GOLD PLUS** is compatible in high electrolyte solutions and offers a wide range of stability in various salts of glyphosate formulations. This high performance proprietary blend is a bio-degradable, patent pending and biological activator for glyphosate formulations.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE NOT FOR AQUATIC USE

**AdjuTec AMS GOLD PLUS** should be used according to the directions on pesticide labels. Rates can range from 1-4 quarts per 100 gallons of spray solution but typical use rates are 2 to 3 quarts per 100 gallons of spray solution and will vary based on pesticide(s) used. Weed type, weed height, environmental conditions and other factors can impact use rate needed. Do not premix with concentrated oil or lecithin products. Add each product separately.

## FIRST AID

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

**Personal Protective Equipment:** Wear chemical-resistant glove, eye protection, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, and shoes plus socks.
