USE RATES

Per Acre: 1 1/4 to 1 1/2 pints (use the higher rate when weeds are under weather stress or at the maximum labeled size for control). By Volume: 1.0% v/v (1 gallon of *INVADE CNL* per 100 gallons of spray solution).

MIXING

In the absence of specific mixing instructions found on the pesticide label, fill the spray tank with at least 50% of the desired finished carrier volume. When premixing in a mixing vessel or inductor, fill with at least 20% of the desired finished carrier volume. While the carrier is aditating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

- 1. Compatibility agent and/or antifoam, if needed
- 2. AMS, dry formulations (WP, DF, WDG, SP), and dry drift retardants
- 3. Dry soluble and suspension fertilizers / micronutrients
- 4. Liquid drift retardants and flowable formulations (F & FL)
- 5. Liquid concentrates, suspension and microencapsulated (LC, SC, ME)
- 6. Emulsifiable concentrates (E, EL or EC)
- 7. Solutions and soluble liquids (S or SL)
- 8. Liquid micronutrients and fertilizers
- 9. Water conditioners and other adjuvants (COC, HSOC, MSO, NIS)
- 10. Finish filling to desired spray volume level and continue agitation
