Warning: Avoid contact with skin, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco. Wear chemical-resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, and shoes plus socks as needed.

FIRST AID

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

MILLER PHEAST is an effective feeding stimulant which has **no pesticidal properties of its own**. However, when mixed with a conventional insecticide, **MILLER PHEAST** encourages increased ingestion of that insecticide, and thereby enhances its efficacy. **MILLER PHEAST** specifically stimulates phytophagous species (those species with chewing mouth parts), to ingest lethal quantities of the admixed insecticide.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION RATE: Apply at a rate of ½ to 5 pounds for formulation per acre (0.56 to 5.60 kg per hectare). Mix with sufficient water for adequate coverage of the crop according to the label of the insecticide being used. May be mixed with Miller Nu Film P®, Miller Nu Film 17®, Surfifix®, Lastick® or other approved spreader/stickers. May be applied by conventional aerial or ground spray equipment. Equipment producing larger droplets is preferred, for enhancing the effectiveness of **MILLER PHEAST**.

The timing of the initial and subsequent applications should be determined by the timing of the insecticide applications.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Fill the mixing tank half full of water and begin good agitation. While agitation continues, add the recommended quantity of **MILLER PHEAST**. When thoroughly suspended in the solution, add the remainder of the recommended water with the insecticide. Continue agitation during mixing and during application.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is not for aquatic use. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, well ventilated area. Avoid contact with high temperatures and moisture. Store sealed to insure integrity of product.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: This product has been packaged for ease of use and minimization of waste. Excess product, or wastes resulting from the use of this product, may be used on site, or must be disposed of in compliance with applicable Federal, State, or Local regulations.
