ROOT FEED can be applied to the root zone by flood, drip, overhead, pivot and micro irrigation systems. Apply the recommended amount with sufficient water to deposit it into the root zone.

RECOMMENDED USES

FOR FERTIGATION: Apply ROOT FEED to the root zone through the irrigation system, at 1 to 5 gallons per acre, every 7 to 14 days. For annual crops start 14 days after transplant or at 2-3 true leaf continue as needed. For perennial deciduous trees, berry bushes and vine crops start application with first root flush and continue through the last nitrogen application. Apply treatment during the later stages of the watering cycle. *Do not use treated seed for food, feed, or oil purposes. Label treated seed in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Seed Act and applicable state and local laws. Use an approved dye to distinguish treated seed and prevent inadvertent use for food, feed or oil purposes.
