STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed. Protect from freezing. Container Handling:
For Non-Refillable Containers:
Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into mix tank or store rinsate for later disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling, if available or dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or, if allowed by government regulations, by burning or incineration. If container is burned, stay out of smoke. Consult Federal, State, or Local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

For Refillable Containers:
Refillable container. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times. Offer for recycling, if available or dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or, if allowed by government regulations, by burning or incineration. If container is burned, stay out of smoke.
