DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STEPUP® FLUENT™ is intended for use as a seed treatment. For corn, soybeans, peas, chickpeas, lentils, peanuts, alfalfa, and other legumes; wheat, canola, and other small grains; cotton, sunflowers, and all other crops: Apply 2.5-3 ounces per unit of seed, or 5-6 ounces of **STEPUP FLUENT** per 100 pounds of seed.

STEPUP FLUENT can be mixed with most fungicides and pesticides. Mix powder well enough to ensure even coverage on seed.

As a planter box treatment: Apply to seed in the planter box, the seed bag, or in a mixing pail.

As a seed finisher: Apply in a manner that allows the treatment to cover all seed surfaces.
