GENERAL INFORMATION

TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10% is a chelated micronutrient designed for foliar or soil application. It is recommended for use as an additive in dry or liquid fertilizers and is compatible with most of the herbicides, insecticides, and agricultural chemicals that can be utilized in combination with liquid fertilizers. TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10% may not be compatible with some liquid fertilizer formulations. A pre-mix "jar test" is recommended prior to mixing with liquid fertilizer to check compatibility.

TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10% is not recommended for use with pesticides which are affected by alkaline hydrolysis or are not compatible with alkaline materials. Foliar fertilization is intended as a supplement to a regular fertilization program and will not, by itself, provide all the nutrients normally required by crops or other intended plants

RECOMMENDED CROPS

TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10% can be applied to the following crops: Vegetables, fruit, row crops, deciduous fruit and nut trees, citrus trees and commercial turf and ornamentals. FOR USE IN WISCONSIN: TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10% can be applied to these crops commonly grown in Wisconsin and requiring a medium to high level of zinc: Barley, Beans (lima, navy), Beets, Canola, Corn (field, sweet), Cucumber, Lettuce, Lupine, Onion, Potato, Radish, Sorghum (grain, sudan), Soybean, Spinach, Tobacco, Tomato.

APPLICATION AND MIXING GUIDE

Rates and timing of applications are dependent on local conditions and individual nutrient management programs and should always be made as a result of soil and/or plant tissue analysis and in conjunction with your local agricultural authority.

TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10% may be applied by ground or aerial application. Use enough water for thorough coverage of foliage or soil.

Use in accordance with recommendations of a qualified individual or institution, such as, but not limited to, a certified crop advisor, agronomist, University Crop Extension publication, or apply according to recommendations in your approved nutrient management plan.

Thorough coverage is necessary for best results and the addition of a nonionic surfactant such as INDUCE® is recommended.

MIXING: In any mixing operation, TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10% should be introduced in the following sequence:

- Water
- TRACITE® LF/ZINC 10%
- Other Fertilizers or Pesticides

In mixtures where a compatibility agent is suggested, a product such as BUFFER P.S.™ is recommended. Local climatic conditions, infestations and other factors affect the performance of any insecticide, fungicide and nutritional spray.
