GENERAL INFORMATION

Transcend is a 90 percent non-ionic surfactant designed to improve the effectiveness pesticides and plant growth regulators. **Transcend** is APE/NPE free, OMRI listed for certain applications, and can be used with fungicides, herbicides, insecticides and plant growth regulators. **Transcend** will increase spray solution wetting and coverage of target leaf surfaces while enhancing deposition and reducing driftable fines.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always mix and apply this product in accordance with the instructions found on the herbicide, insecticide, fungicide or plant growth regulator label regarding adjuvants. In the absence of specific instructions follow the application and mixing guidelines below.





USE RATES

- Ground: 0.125-0.5% v/v (1–4 pints pint per 100 gallons of spray solution).
- Aerial: 0.25-0.5% v/v (2–4 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution).

MIXING

In the absence of specific mixing instructions found on the herbicide, insecticide, fungicide or plant growth regulator label, fill the spray tank with at least 50% of the desired finished carrier volume. When premixing in a mixing vessel or inductor, fill with at least 20% of the desired finished carrier volume. While the carrier is agitating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

- 1. Compatibility agent and/or antifoam, if needed
- 2. AMS, dry formulations (WP, DF, WDG, SP), and dry drift retardants
- 3. Dry soluble and suspension fertilizers / micronutrients
- 4. Liquid drift retardants and flowable formulations (F & FL)
- Liquid concentrates, suspension concentrates, microencapsulated and capsule suspension (LC, SC, ME, CS)
- 6. Emulsifiable concentrates (E, EL or EC)
- 7. Solutions and soluble liquids (S or SL)
- 8. Liquid micronutrients and fertilizers
- 9. Water conditioners and other adjuvants (COC, HSOC, MSO, NIS)
- 10. Finish filling to desired spray volume level and continue agitation
