GENERAL INFORMATION

ValCheck delivers a drift reduction agent, water conditioner, surfactant, and defoamer for use with dicamba and other herbicides. It contains buffering and chelating agents designed to block hard water cations from interacting with weak acid herbicides like glyphosate and dicamba and aid in maintaining proper pH in the tank-mix solution. ValCheck is built without ammonium sulfate (AMS) and includes a non-ionic surfactant.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Rate of Application

Add 0.5% volume to volume or 2 quarts per 100 gallons.

- 2. Add desired rate of ValCheck to water before adding pesticides.
